Most of our children spend four years in the school. They join the school as three year olds in the Nursery. Parents then apply for them to move into the full time Reception for the following year. The children then move into Key Stage One for year one, then year two.

There is an induction period for children, their families and staff to get to know each other at the start of Nursery and Reception.

We have parents evenings twice each year, but parents are encouraged to talk to the staff about any concerns at other times. All classes have ten minutes each morning when parents/carers settle their child into the classroom and when they can talk to staff.

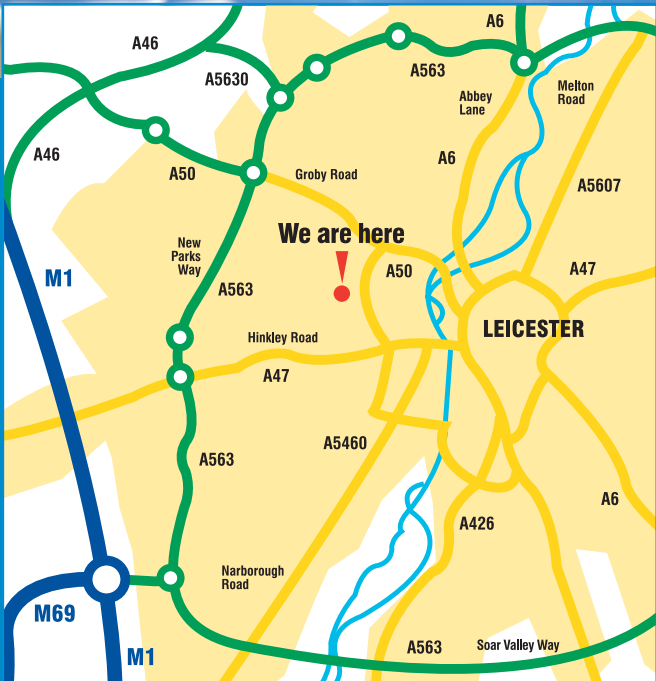
