<b>Good</b>	<b>97%</b>	6 School days absent Still making progress
<b>Fair</b>	<b>95%</b>	9.5 School days absent We will ask for evidence to support absences Harder to make progress
<b>Poor</b>	<b>92%</b>	15 School days absent Education Welfare Service actively involved Less chance of success
<b>Unacceptable</b>	<b>90%</b>	19 School days absent. Persistently Absent Needs to improve immediately at risk of prosecution Serious impact on education and life chances
